## Directions

1. Head east on I-10 E from I-10 Bltwy 8 Interchange go 1.4 mi
2. Take exit 758A - Bunker Hill Rd go 0.6 mi
3. Turn left at Bunker Hill Rd go 0.4 mi
4. Turn right at Long Branch Ln go 0.1 mi
6. Turn left at Springrock Ln go 0.2 mi
5. Destination will be on the right.



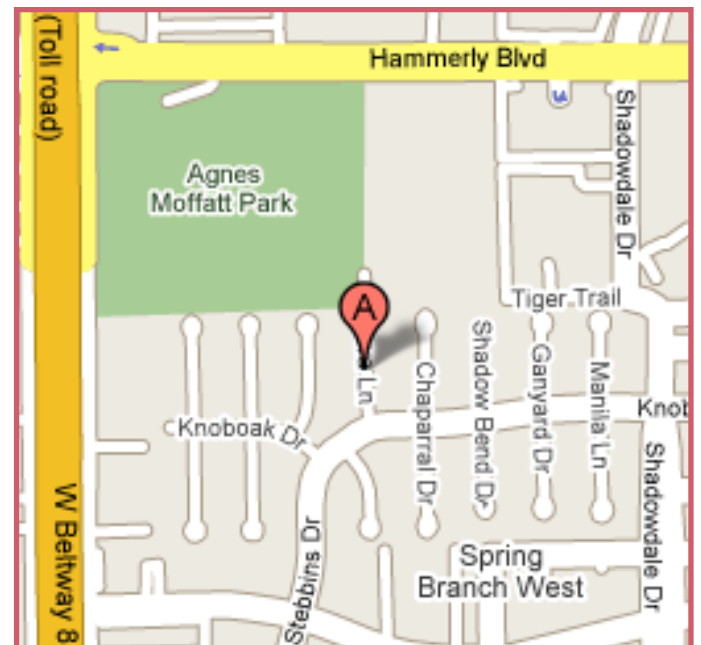
# RITA KNOWLES' GARDEN

## Directions

1. From the 1/10 Katy/Bltwy 8 Interchange, head north on W Sam Houston Tollway N go 1.7 mi
  2. Take the Hammerly Blvd/Kempwood Dr exit go 0.5 mi
  3. Turn right at Hammerly Blvd go 0.5 mi
  4. Turn right at Shadowdale Dr go 0.2 mi
  5. Turn left to stay on Shadowdale Dr go 207 ft
  6. Turn right to stay on Shadowdale Dr go 482 ft
  7. Turn right at Knoboak Dr go 0.3 mi
  8. Turn right at Ottawa Ln go 299 ft
- Destination will be on the left.



# DIANE WALKER'S GARDEN

Diane Walker's garden is located in Camp Logan neighborhood adjacent to Memorial Park. An example of gardening in a small space it makes the most of limited space. Amazingly, there are two courtyards, a pond, beds for sun, filtered light and shade as well as little yard art and an arbor covered with fig ivy. Also, be sure to take notice of the native and drought tolerant planting and oak trees in the triangular island in front of the home adopted by Diane and her neighbors.

## Directions

1. From the I-10/610 Interchange go east on I-10 E for 1.2 mi
2. Take exit 764 for Washington Ave go 0.3 mi
3. Turn right at Westcott St (signs for Westcott St To Washington Ave) go 0.5 mi
4. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Arnot St go 354 ft
5. Turn right at Taggart St go 184 ft  
Destination will be on the left.



# PEGGY MOORE'S GARDEN

Seven years ago I retired, moved to Houston and built a new house. I have a small space and my garden is relatively young, but I am certainly enjoying Houston gardening. The gardens have cottage style plantings in curving beds. The cornerstone of the gardens are the trees, crape myrtles and live oaks complimented by a variety of shrubs including cleysera, holly, Indian hawthorn, and wax leaf ligustrum along with a collection of perennials and annuals. Day lilies, roses, and iris are among my favorite plant that add color to the garden. Like most gardens mine is evolving and will never be quite 'finished'.

## Directions

1. Head north on TX-6 from I-10/Katy Fwy go 6.5 mi
2. Turn left at FM 529 Rd go 1.4 mi
3. Turn right at Queenston Blvd go 3.3 mi
4. Turn right at Opal Meadow Dr go 203 ft
5. Turn right at Pavonia Dr go 0.2 mi
6. Continue on Cobalt Falls Dr go 0.2 mi
7. Turn right at Linden Springs Dr go 358 ft
8. Turn right at Linden Springs Ct. go 102 ft  
Destination will be on the right.
